Today is National Kindness Day, and I wanted to take the opportunity to thank you on behalf of the staff, for all the kindnesses that you have shown us during the pandemic.

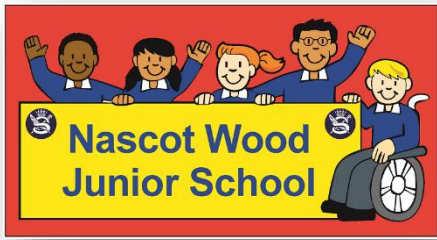
This week's report is a short update, as I do not have new information for you at the moment.
