Dear Parents,

I hope that you are all keeping well and managing this difficult situation.

I am impressed by what I am hearing from your children's Teachers about the quality of their online learning. They have done so well to adapt to the changes; many thanks for all the support you have given them with this.

I sent the children a message on google classroom on Wednesday, congratulating them on all they have achieved so far and asking them to consider the following rules for their virtual morning meetings:

- Please can the children be washed, dressed and ready for their morning lesson with their Teacher
- Wear something smart – this could be their school uniform (no pyjamas or nightwear are permitted)
- Be aware that whatever is in the background can be seen by all the children in the meeting

It is understandable that this new way of working will take some adjustment and we are happy to support you by answering any queries or questions.

On the following page I have again included the learning during lockdown guidelines, should you have missed them last week. This has been slightly amended to include up to date information.

# Learning during lockdown

Here are some guidelines for your information:

- All Class Teachers are holding a google meeting every morning at 9am or 9.30am (timings are on google classroom). *These are compulsory for the children to attend.*
- All Class Teachers are running a catch up session every afternoon, to enable children to ask the Teacher questions about the work, or to have a chat. *Attendance for these sessions is voluntary.*
- There will be between 4 and 5 hours of work set for your children each day. They are expected to complete as much as they can each day.
- Class Teachers will check and comment on your children's submitted work.
- We have now made contact with every child in the school, and nearly all of them are engaging in virtual lessons and online learning
- Children from upper key stage 2 (years 5 and 6) have been working in virtual groups throughout the school day. I will keep you informed as we continue to develop our remote learning offer.

*Over the last few days there have been some brief interruptions to the google meetings that Teachers have been having with the children.*

*Please can we request that parents do not get involved in these sessions and, if there is a need to contact the Class Teacher, they book an appointment by contacting the school office.*


## Future Plans

Would you be interested in booking your child(ren) into a school-run breakfast club?




Would you be interested in booking your child(ren) into a school-run after school club?

What would be your preferred start time for Breakfast Club?


68 responses



Would you prefer breakfast to be included at a higher price or no breakfast at a lower price?





For approximately how many days per week would you book your child(ren) into the Breakfast Club?



What would be your preferred latest collection time for After School Club?



(Note that a drink and snack will be provided if no supper is offered)


