Dear Parents,

I haven't got too much to report to you today, following my report to you on Tuesday.

However, I did want to say that we are very much looking forward to welcoming your children back to school on Monday 8th March.

We have been working hard to continue to improve the site for the children's return.

Mr Harrison has removed the old bike shelters, to improve the light in year 3 classrooms and we are waiting for the delivery of new bike racks.

If your child cycles to school, they can leave their bike outside their classrooms in the meantime.

Work has begun on clearing all the classrooms and preparing them for new flooring and carpeting. The contractor has agreed to work at the weekends in order to try to complete all the classrooms before the children return.

Just to alert you to the fact that an underground water leak has been identified outside the main reception area. The water board will therefore be carrying out some remedial work to solve this problem. Please take care if you need to use the front entrance of the school.

Just to remind you, we have asked Herts Catering to provide school lunches for the children from Monday 8th March, when the school reopens.

This will be a hot food option, served in a takeaway box and distributed to the classrooms.
