Nature of support 2017/18

The attainment and progress of pupils in receipt of pupil progress grant is closely monitored by the Senior Leadership Team and by all members of staff. Our results show that disadvantaged pupils do better than the national all, and that is because these pupils are targeted in Teacher's planning and have a significant amount of the Class Teacher's time.

Analysing the areas of particular disadvantage for these pupils, enables us to target specific, effective support.
