Y4 Visit to Bhaktivedanta Manor Thursday 19th October 2023

This year in their RE lessons, Year 4 will be learning about Hindu beliefs, customs and festivals. To enhance their learning, we have arranged a visit to the Bhaktivedanta Manor in Aldenham, on Thursday 19th October. This trip has always been regarded as a highlight of their time at this school.

The children will have a tour of the grounds (coats and outdoor footwear are essential!); they will see the farm animals and maybe have a ride in a bullock cart. Inside the house they will have an interactive session about Hinduism and the shrine; they will be given opportunities to try on Hindu costume and learn some traditional face-painting designs.

Only vegetarian food is permitted on the site, and a highlight of the day is the very popular vegetarian meal provided for everyone. If your child has any food allergies of which we need to be aware, please let us know.

We shall be leaving school by coach at approximately 9.15am and returning during the afternoon. The cost of the coach and entrance fee (including lunch) is **£22.90** which is payable via School Gateway. If insufficient contributions are received, then the activity may not be able to take place.

Experiences such as this are invaluable to the children's development, both educationally and culturally, so we thank you for your continued support.
