We unite across faiths, cultures and backgrounds to remember the service and sacrifice of the Armed Forces community from Britain and the Commonwealth.

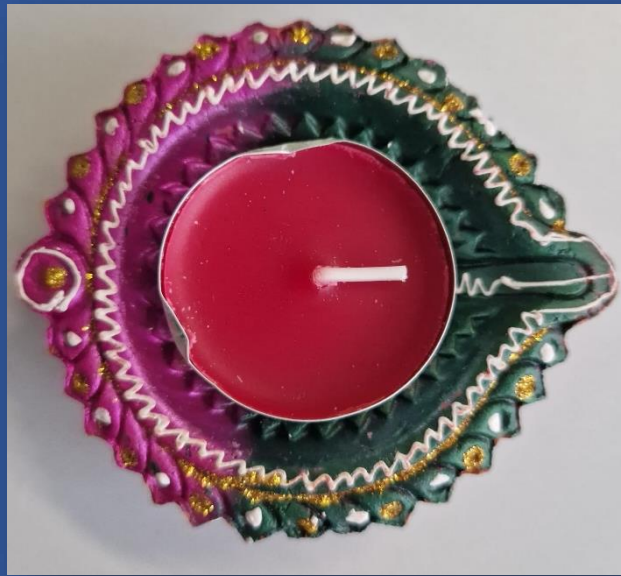
By remembering we learn to look first for a peaceful solution to problems that we have, so that this peace will affect others and spread across the world.
