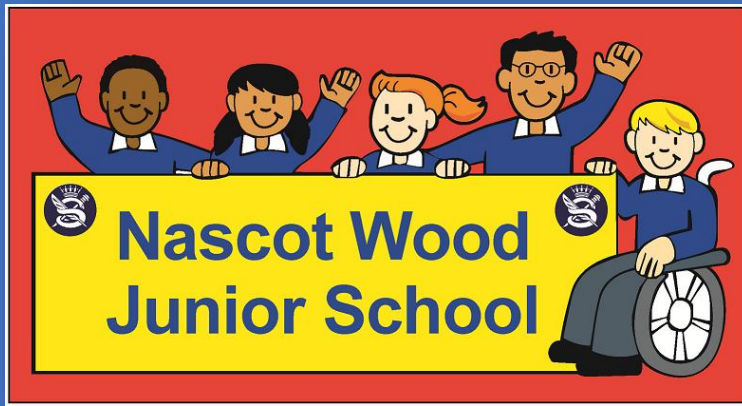

It has been formatted to be read on a smartphone for easy access.

Each week, I will include all or some of the following information:

- A thought for the week, reflecting a particular focus, religious observance or something I have been thinking about. This links to our focus on positive mental health and wellbeing
- Art of the week. I often include a piece of art from a child or children. These pieces will usually be shown in Friday's achievement assembly. In addition, I choose a piece each week to display in the school library for everyone to enjoy
- Any reminders or important information for parents
- A timetable of events for the term
- Photos of any school trips/events that have taken place
- Job adverts as and when they occur
- Weekly attendance data for each class – our target is 97% attendance each week
- Stars of the week
