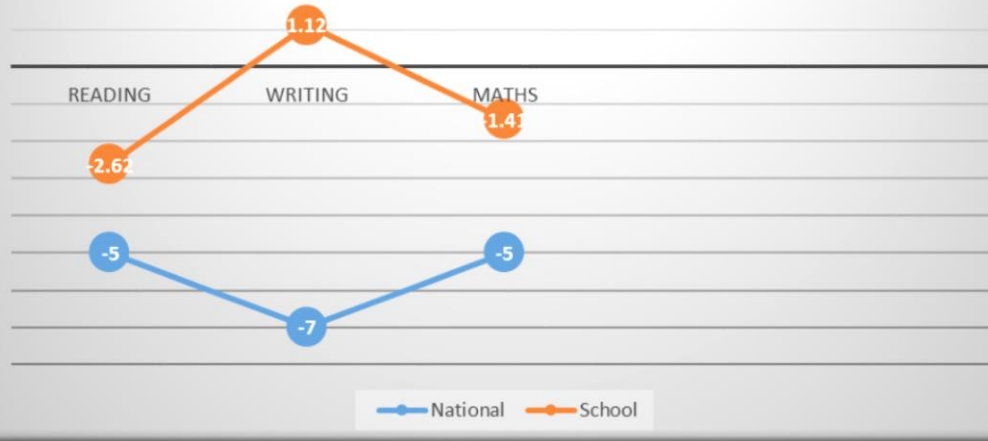


Pupil Premium grant impact report: 2015/16

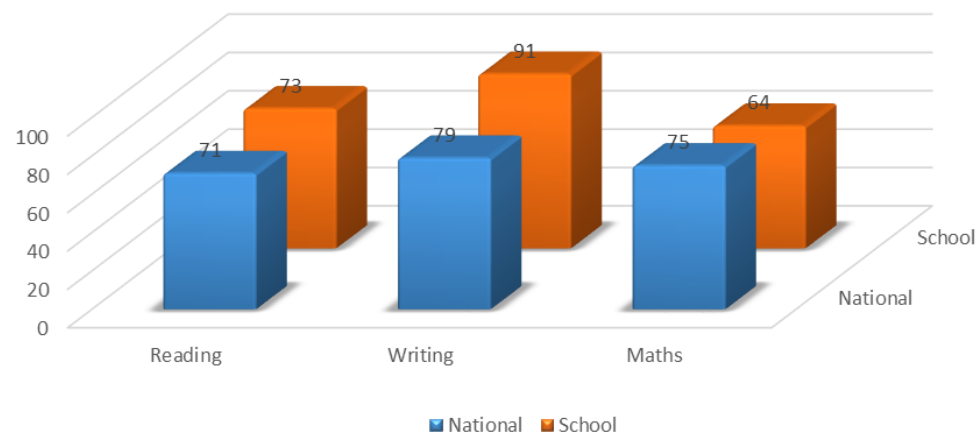
The progress of our disadvantaged pupils is above the national non-disadvantaged in all areas.

In school gap between FSM and non FSM



There is an in-school progress gap between our FSM and non FSM children in Reading, but there is no gap in Writing and Maths. It is important to note that 5 out of 11 children in receipt of PPG also had SEND.

Percentage of disadvantaged children achieving expected or above



The percentage of our disadvantaged children achieving expected or above progress was above national in Reading and Writing, but below in Mathematics.
